Dear Parents,

Today, Wednesday, December 20th, will be the last day of classes. The winter break begins December 21st, and goes through January 3rd. **Students will return from winter break on Thursday, January 4th.**

While we understand that there are times when our children are going to have some sick days, it is imperative that our children come to school as often as possible. Our attendance rate has slowly, but steadily dropped from 94.3% to 93.9% within the past 30 days. The state requires us to have at least a 94%. This is extremely detrimental to our children's education. Some things to consider:

1. School starts at 7:20. The tardy bell is at 7:30, no exceptions. If students come to school after 8:40, they are considered a half day late. Please make sure your children are at school on time.
2. Even excused absences are still considered absences. They are still a part of the absence record. Since school is out at 2:35, please try to make doctor appointments for after school.
3. Student absences are considered chronic after 6 days of missing school. If your child has missed more than 6 days, you are in danger of being reported to truancy.
4. Even during cold weather, we still have school. The building is warm, and we will take good care of the kids!

Please help us by doing your part to ensure that your child is getting the best opportunity possible to receive a proper education by getting them to school every day.
