ONE EXTRA MINUTE OF YOUR TIME COULD SAVE YOUR CHILD'S LIFE! Parents, please help us keep your child safe. Set an example and insist that your child use the crosswalks that are marked to cross streets and parking lots. The end of the school day is the most congested with cars, vans, buses, and CHILDREN. Everyone must follow the directions of the crossing guards, duty teachers, and traffic signs. You make a difference between a safe return home and a tragedy.

When a child is absent from school, it is his/her responsibility to get the assignments missed from his/her teacher(s). Parents are not responsible for picking up assignments for their child unless the child is absent for an extended period of time. After a child has been absent three consecutive days, parents may request make-up work from their child's teachers by calling the school office. Twenty-four hours after contacting the office, work will be available for pick-up in the school office between 3:00 p.m. and 3:30 p.m. Upon returning to school, a student will have one day to make up work for each one day he/she was absent. Weekends are counted as make-up workdays.
